



**The Announcement of Sarawittaya School
Regarding the Recruitment of a Full Time Foreign Teacher (General Program)**

Sarawittaya School, a secondary school located at Senanikom Sub-District, Chatuchak District, Bangkok, is seeking for a qualified and enthusiastic foreign English teacher to teach English in our school. **The job will start on 16th May 2026.**

1. Details about the Position

Foreign teachers for Foreign Language Department **1 position** responsible for

1.1 Teaching English Subject for students who studies at grade 7-12 (Mattayom 1-6)

1.2 Other duties assigned by the school.

1.3 Salary:

For native English speaker, the salary is 40,000 baht per month.

For Non – native English speaker, the salary is 30,000 baht per month.

2. Qualifications of Applicants

2.1 The applicant must be male or female, age between 23 – 55 years old.

2.2 The applicant must be a native English speaker (the British, American, Canadian, Australian, or New Zealander) or Non–native English speaker, the foreigners who use English as a second language, (South African, Filipino, Dutch Netherlanders, Swedish, Irish). For non – native English speaker, they must have been educated in English-speaking countries for at least one year, having English language proficiency test or English proficiency test from trusted institutions.

2.3 The applicant must be able to teach English Subject which is based on the school Curriculum and textbooks in junior and senior high school level and focus on children centered learning and using a variety of teaching methods

2.4 The applicant must have a dedicated positive and flexible attitude towards students and teachers.

2.5 The applicant must be willing to accept and help extra works assigned by the Thai teachers, the Head of Foreign Language Department and the Director of Sarawittaya School.

2.6 The applicant must have a valid passport.

2.7 The applicant must have a valid Profession Teaching License for Foreign Teachers from the Teachers' Council of Thailand.

2.8 The applicant must have a bachelor's degree or higher (A degree in education and/or Teaching Experiences in secondary schools would be advantage.)

3. The Responsibilities

- 3.1 The applicant must perform duties from 07.30 a.m. - 3.30 p.m. from Monday to Friday.
- 3.2 The applicant must be able to teach students based on the school schedule and attend the activities of Foreign Language Department and other extra works assigned.
- 3.3 The applicant must write lesson plans for learning management based on school curriculum focusing on children-centered learning.
- 3.4 The applicant must design and conduct educational evaluation and assessment.
- 3.5 The applicant must train the students to compete in various activities which is related to English Language both inside and outside the school.

- 4.1.3 Teaching Demonstration and Interviewing will take place at Sarawittaya School on 6th March 2026, Venue 135, Building 1.
- 4.1.4 The selection result will be announced on the school's website (<http://www.srv.ac.th>) on 12th March 2026.

4.2 Documents must be attached with the application form.

Applicants are required to prepare all original documents along with one certified copy of each. applicants must scan and upload all supporting documents (Items 4.2.1 – 4.2.7) via the attached e-mail [fldsrv@srv.ac.th]. Furthermore, both original documents and certified copies must be presented in person on the day of the interview/demonstration.

- 4.2.1 A copy of a valid Profession Teaching License for Foreign Teachers issued by the Teachers' Council of Thailand
- 4.2.2 A copy of valid passport and your national identity card
- 4.2.3 A copy of educational certificate (Transcript of records)

- 4.2.4 Two recent formal Photos (Do not wear a hat and do not wear black eyeglasses)
1 x 1.5 inches (Photo must be taken not more than 6 months)
- 4.2.5 A recent medical certificate (Issued not more than 1 month and certified that the applicant is in good physical and mental health)
- 4.2.6 If the applicant had changed the name must provide the documents as a proof of evidence to support the changes he or she had made for his or her identification. (if any)
- 4.2.7 A copy of certificate of working experiences (if any)

5. Contract and Conditions

We offer a year contract for three applicants who passed the selection; they have to report to the contract on **31st March 2026** at 9.00 a.m. at The Budgeting Department of Sarawittaya School. From that, they have to be responsible for obtaining his or her own housing, Visa, Work Permit, Medical Certificate and teacher license. The duration of the contract is for 1 year. Their salary will be reviewed annually. At the end of the contract, three applicants will be evaluated to renew their contract. The duration of employment is from **16th May 2026 – 16th April 2027 (11 months)**. Please note that if the applicant who passed the selection in the previous order does not contact the school, the school will call the applicant in the next order.
